General definitions and interpretations

The 'Territorial limits' definition is deleted and replaced with the undernoted:

- b) for section - Legal Expenses, territorial limit means:
  - i) for insured incidents Legal Defence (excluding Statutory notice appeals), and Bodily injury:  
the European Union, the Isle of Man, the Channel Islands, Albania, Andorra, Bosnia Herzegovina, Croatia, Gibraltar, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Macedonia, Monaco, Montenegro, Norway, San Marino, Serbia, Switzerland and Turkey.
  - ii) for all other insured incidents:  
the United Kingdom and any other extension agreed with us.
